## Technology Development Grants

Grant	Description	Deadlines
<b>Technology Enhancement Grant</b>	For university technology transfer offices to support research and other commercially important activities that will make a technology licensable.  <i>Maximum: \$50,000</i>	

## Business Loans

Grant or Loan	Description	Deadlines
<b>Company Inception (CIL)</b>	Supports business inception and related activities that are critical to the early-stage start-up of a company.  <i>Maximum: \$30,000</i>	<i>Rolling</i>
<b>Small Business Innovation Research Bridge Loan (RBL)</b>	Available to SBIR/STTR Phase I grant recipients to fund a research project that maintains technology development momentum while the company applies for Phase II funding.	<i>Rolling</i>
<b>Small Business Research (SRL)</b>	Assists companies by supporting applied research critical to the development of products, processes, services or tools with clear commercial potential. Requires the co-submission of a research proposal and a business plan.	<i>Rolling</i>
<b>Strategic Growth (SGL)</b>	Matches Biotechnology Center loan support with "angel network" or venture capital investments to help bootstrap biotechnology companies that have already established technical proof-of-concept and require further corporate development support.  <i>A maximum of two SGL's allowed per company.</i>	<i>Rolling</i>

Duration and Max Award Amount	Phase I ~6 months and \$100K; Phase II - 2 years and \$750K	Phase I ~1 year and \$100K; Phase II - 2 years and \$750K
PI	Employed with small business	May be employed with either small business or non-profit research institution (but varies)

# Current NC Funding Opportunities

- NCBC Collaborative Funding Grant (CFG)  
(**Due Date: 7/27/11**)
  - The grant financially supports a university-company partnership by providing funding for a postdoctoral fellow or technician in a university laboratory.
  - The award is \$40,000 to \$50,000 per year based on the partner company's size. Total funding with match is \$80,000 per year for two years.

# Current Federal Funding Opportunities

- EPA FY-2011 SBIR (**Due Date: 5/3/11**)
  - EPA is particularly interested in technologies which address the environmental implications of biofuels, making their manufacture and use more sustainable (*Sustainable Utilization of Biomass* topic). Areas of interest include but are not limited to:
    - New, more efficient and cost effective methods for storing and transporting biomass raw materials.
    - Technologies to improve process efficiencies and reduce air and water emissions and waste disposal impacts from biofuel production plants.

# Current Federal Funding Opportunities

- *USDA Nanoscale Science and Technology to Ensure Safe Food* (**Due Date: 5/14/11**)
  - Adequate attention must be given to develop scientific understanding of fate/transport and behavior of engineered nanomaterials in food, agriculture production, and the environment to ensure safe use of nanotechnology.
  - Eligible applicants include state agricultural experiment stations; colleges and universities (including junior colleges offering associate degrees or higher); university research foundations; other research institutions and organizations; federal agencies; national laboratories; private organizations or corporations; individuals who are U.S. citizens, nationals, or permanent residents; and any group consisting of two or more entities identified above.

  - GOALI promotes university-industry partnerships by making project funds or fellowships/traineeships available to support an eclectic mix of industry-university linkages.
  - Special interest is focused on affording the opportunity for (1) faculty, postdoctoral fellows, and students to conduct research and gain experience in an industrial setting; (2) industrial scientists and engineers to bring industry's perspective and integrative skills to academe; and (3) interdisciplinary university-industry teams to conduct research projects.

Just like you, the State of North Carolina has to balance its income and expenses. The Governor and the General Assembly work together to create a budget, and they adjust that budget as needs and priorities change and income fluctuates.

The State gets money from many sources, including taxes (on income, sales and use, motor fuels, cigarettes, etc.), fees (like hunting/fishing licenses, or tuition at a community college, or fines for breaking a law), and grants and assistance from the Federal Government (to support schools, highway building, Medicaid and other programs).

The State also spends money on many projects and services, like public schools, community colleges, and universities, building and maintaining roads and bridges, inspecting elevators, providing health care and shelter for people in need, protecting the environment, and making sure our communities are safe. Much of this spending is in the form of contracts, grants, and other types of assistance, like loans or direct payments for goods and services.
