Databases

Biopharm Insight and Biopharm Forecast

A drug development pipeline, directory of companies and executives, and drug sales and forecasting rolled into one searchable database. Also includes Device and Outsourcing databases.

PharmaDeals

A comprehensive database of pharma and biotech deals, licensing and M&A, including all publicly available financial details. Searchable by date, partner, deal type, therapeutic area, etc.

Innovaro (fka: Knowledge Express)

A collection of databases covering licensing opportunities, company profiles, royalty rates, domestic and international patents and applications, drug development pipeline, clinical trial results, industry news and market intelligence.

Factiva

Dow Jones' news database, including major global newswires and newspapers.

ScienceDirect*

Elsevier's corporate edition of science and technical journals, comprising approximately 25% of the scientific literature, with links to full text articles.

Morningstar Document Research (fka: 10K Wizard)

A database of SEC filings from public and private companies.
